Discoveries in Kimmeridge

The end of December proved to be quite a productive time for the collecting of new fossils here at the museum. The cold weather can deter many people, but it never stops Steve from heading out on a hunt for fossils, including Christmas Day! As a result, the museum is now home to several new additions to the collection, and hopefully there will be many more to come in the new year. Interestingly, it wasn't just Steve who brought back some new specimens, Ash Hall our media guy also came back with some specimens that have made it into the reserve collection. The new additions include a new Aspidorhynchus specimen, a plesiosaur belly rib, an isolated fish bone (pictured below) and some more ichthyosaur material. These additions all add to the story we are telling here at the museum, by providing further evidence of Kimmeridgian life. As with all of Steve's trips out, he comes across many fossils, most do not make it into the collection, but that is not always the case though. Nick Nugent our Museum Education Coordinator sent Steve out with a specific request to collect some coprolite fossils suitable for use as "show and tell" pieces for our educational visits. Steve very kindly obliged.

We announced the news in December that the museum was awarded with £219,500 towards the gallery refit project from the DCMS/Wolfson Museums and Galleries Improvement Fund. This is massive for the museum; I am absolutely delighted with the news, because we are a Designated and Accredited Museum, it is vital that we continue the important work of preserving our collection for future generations. The gallery refit will also enable us to prepare, conserve as well as develop and expand the Collection as a visitor attraction, research facility and educational centre. Although this money will go a long way to completing the project, we still need to raise a considerable amount of money for this critical gallery refit project.
